BACKGROUND: The Impact Fee Advisory Committee (IFAC) currently has three vacant positions:

1. Citizen of Bozeman not Employed in the Development Industry, with a term ending December 31, 2019
2. Citizen of Bozeman not Employed in the Development Industry, with a term ending December 31, 2020
3. Builder, with a term ending December 31, 2020

One new application has been received for the Citizen of Bozeman not Employed in the Development Industry position, with a term ending December 31, 2020.

The Impact Fee Advisory Committee, established under 7-6-1604, MCA, shall consist of nine members to be appointed by the City Commission. The members shall be:
